- ★ Begin the net after the W3HAC Net (approximately 8:20PM)
- ★ Be sure to identify with your FCC call once every 10 minutes and at end of the net
- ★ Use attached log format or similar and report out to groups.io reflector within 72 hours

Calling the District of Columbia Amateur Radio Emergency Services Training Net.

Your net control station for this session is {{YOUR CALLSIGN PHONETICALLY}}.

The ARES DC Training Net meets each Monday evening, following the HacDC Club Net, on the K3MRC 145.430 repeater with a PL tone of 114.8. If the K3MRC repeater fails for any reason, the net will move to the KC3VO 448.875 repeater with no PL tone.

The purpose of this net is to practice directed net operations, provide public service information, and encourage interest in ARES in the District. We invite all licensed amateur stations to check in and participate in the net, regardless of location or affiliation.

Is there an Alternate Net Control Station on frequency? Please give your call phonetically.

- Wait to hear if an ANCS checks in then acknowledge that station.
- ANCS station should keep a shadow log in case the NCS can no longer operate the net.

This is a directed net. Please address all transmissions to the Net Control Station and do not transmit non-emergency traffic until instructed by Net Control.

When checking into the net please give your call sign phonetically and slowly followed by your first name and operating location. If you have not been heard or if you need to make a correction, please wait until instructed by Net Control to repeat your check-in.

Are there any stations with emergency or priority traffic?

• Accept check-ins. PAUSE to be sure you get them all. Ask for corrections if needed.

The net will now accept check-ins from portable, mobile or stations on emergency power. Please give your call phonetically, first name, and location.

• Accept check-ins. PAUSE to be sure you get them all. Ask for corrections if needed. Note in the log that the station is portable, mobile or on emergency power.

The net will now accept general check-ins from all stations not yet recognized. Please give your call phonetically, first name, and location.

• Accept check-ins. PAUSE to be sure you get them all. Ask for corrections if needed.

The net will now take announcements, comments, or questions.

• Call each station on the net starting with NCS, then ANCS, then all other stations in order of check-in.

Are there any additional stations wishing to check into the District of Columbia Amateur Radio Emergency Service net?

- Accept check-ins. PAUSE to be sure you get them all. Ask for corrections if needed.
- Call additional stations in order for announcements, comments, or questions.

If there are any additional comments for the net, please give your call.

• Call stations with additional comments in order.
